ACADEMIC DETENTION

Academic Detention is held daily from Monday to Thursday for 1 hour starting immediately after school. A specific teacher is on duty. Pupils are put into Academic Detention for academic-related problems such as:

2. Pupils who are wasting time in class.

TOASTMASTERS – GRADE 11

A group of our Grade 11 pupils will have the opportunity of participating in a public speaking course based on the Toastmasters’ programme. This programme has been developed to teach pupils public-speaking skills, how to conduct meetings, and, in the process, improve their self-confidence. The programme consists of nine two-and-a-half hour sessions (15h00 -17h30). The sessions will be held on Mondays. The final session takes place on WEDNESDAY, 6 October 2010 and is a graduation dinner to which parents are invited to see their children put their newly-acquired skills to the test.

FRIDAY DETENTION

This detention will last a full two hours (14h00 – 16h00) and will be supervised by educators who will be present at all times. Learners will be expected to remain completely inactive and absolutely silent. Learners will be given at least ONE day's warning.

Postponement can only be authorised by the Principal or Deputy Principal and will only be considered under exceptional circumstances.

Friday detention could be used for:

1. refusal to do other punishment or failure to attend Academic or Break detention;
2. persistent misbehaviour;
3. truancy;
4. consistent use of unacceptable or abusive language;
5. aggressive behaviour, fighting or minor cases of bullying;
6. minor cases of vandalism;
7. cases of dishonesty, insolence or insubordination;
8. smoking;
9. any behaviour that discredits the School, e.g. misbehaviour on public transport.
